

ISPH World Gold Award Selection Guidelines

1st Edition

Article 1 — Purpose

These Guidelines are established by the International Society for Precision Health (hereinafter "the Society") to encourage the submission of outstanding products that align with the Society's mission and the principles of precision health, and to elevate product quality, scientific rigor, industry innovation, and international visibility.

Article 2 — Award Title

The award established under these Guidelines shall be designated the "**ISPH Gold Award**" (hereinafter "the Award").

Article 3 — Implementation

The 1st ISPH World Gold Award shall be conducted beginning in 2026.

Products that are reviewed and selected as award recipients shall hold their award status for a period of **five (5) years**.

Article 4 — Eligibility

Any domestic or international company duly established in accordance with applicable law may apply, provided that its submitted product aligns with the Society's mission and embodies the principles of precision health, innovation, practical applicability, or social value.

Each applicant company is limited to submitting **one (1) product per application cycle**.

Article 5 — Submission Requirements

Applicants shall submit a completed application form and all required supporting materials in accordance with the Society's published guidelines. Where necessary, the Society may request supplementary documentation, including but not limited to product descriptions, scientific evidence, inspection or testing reports, quality management records, research and development outcomes, or other materials relevant to the review process.

In cases of incomplete submissions, the Society shall notify the applicant and allow a designated period for remediation. Failure to provide the required materials within the stipulated timeframe shall result in disqualification of the application.

Article 6 — Application Fee

The application fee for the Award is as follows:

1. **General applicants:** USD 10,000 per product.
2. **Organizational members of the Society:** USD 5,000 per product.

Article 7 — Review Committee

The Society may convene a professional Review Committee responsible for evaluating, scoring, and rendering decisions on all matters related to the Award. Review Committee members shall be appointed by the Society from among qualified scholars, subject-matter experts, and professionals in relevant fields.

Article 8 — Review Criteria

The evaluation of submitted products shall be based on a comprehensive assessment of the following criteria:

3. Alignment with the principles and vision of precision health.
4. Scientific basis, technical foundation, and evidence-based support of the product.
5. Product quality, safety, and credibility.
6. Innovation, market applicability, and development potential.
7. Contribution to health promotion, social well-being, or industry advancement.

The Award shall be granted on a competitive, merit-based basis. The Society reserves the right to withhold the Award if no submission meets the requisite standards.

Article 9 — Refund Policy

Applicants whose products do not receive the Award following review shall be entitled to a refund of **50%** of the application fee paid.

However, no refund shall be issued in any of the following circumstances:

8. The applicant voluntarily withdraws the submission after registration.
9. The submitted materials contain false, inaccurate, fabricated, or falsified information.
10. The applicant fails to cooperate with the Society's review procedures as required.
11. Any other circumstance determined by the Society to constitute non-compliance with the application requirements.

Article 10 — Award Validity Period

The award status of products receiving the ISPH World Gold Award shall be valid for **five (5) years** from the date of the Society's official announcement of the award.

Upon expiration of the validity period, any company wishing to continue using the Award title, insignia, or associated promotional designations must re-apply and successfully complete the review process.

Article 11 — Rights of Award Recipients

During the validity period, award-winning products may use the ISPH World Gold Award title, insignia, and associated promotional language in accordance with the Society's applicable regulations.

Article 12 — Obligations and Revocation

The Society reserves the right to revoke the award status of any recipient company and

to suspend its use of the Award title and insignia if any of the following circumstances arise:

12. The product or related information is found to be in serious violation of applicable laws or regulations.
13. Significant concerns arise regarding the product's quality, safety, or compliance.
14. External communications by the company are found to contain false, exaggerated, or misleading claims.
15. The company's conduct damages the Society's reputation or contravenes the Society's mission.
16. Any other circumstance determined by the Society, upon deliberation, to render the company unfit to retain award status.

Article 13 — Conflict of Interest

Any Review Committee member who has a personal, financial, or professional interest in an applicant company or its submitted product must proactively disclose such interest and recuse themselves from the relevant review proceedings.

Article 14 — Supplementary Provisions

Any matters not addressed by these Guidelines shall be governed by the Society's relevant regulations or resolved by resolution of the joint meeting of the Board of Directors and Board of Supervisors.

Article 15 — Entry into Force

These Guidelines shall enter into force upon approval by the joint meeting of the Board of Directors and Board of Supervisors. The same procedure shall apply to any future amendments.
